This letter serves as a supplement to the enclosed form to further explain changes with Spartan Motors, Inc. Effective January 31, 2020, Spartan Motors, Inc. (Spartan) divested its Emergency Response business and Spartan Motors USA, Inc. As such, Spartan no longer manufacturers chassis cabs (incomplete vehicles) that are to be completed as a fire apparatus and no longer builds completed fire apparatus.

Spartan will continue to manufacturer final stage vehicles under its Utilimaster and Royal Truck Body brands. Spartan will also continue to manufacturer incomplete motor home chassis under its Specialty Vehicle business unit as well alter completed vehicles under its Utilimaster brand. Enclosed herewith is a spreadsheet summarizing the manufacturer and vehicle types that now apply Spartan.
