This letter notifies the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration that Polaris Industries Inc. (Polaris) intends to produce the electric low speed vehicle (LSV) models listed below, with a VIN structure that begins with the WMI "52C". The vehicles meet the requirements of 49 CFR Part 571.500.

The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) system will use the World manufacturer Identifier 52C that was issued to Polaris Industries Inc.
